Common Energy Retrofits

Lighting

- Replace Incandescent bulbs (Save \$6 Bulb/yr and 120 lbs CO2/yr)
- Install Sensors

Water Heaters

 Install heat pump water heaters (Save \$330/yr)

Refrigeration

 Replace outdated refrigeration systems (Save \$150/yr and 1,000 lbs of CO2/yr)

HVAC Systems (Heating and Cooling)

- Inspect and clean regularly
- Use the Energy Star
 Building Checklist to
 improve insulation (Save
 \$150-\$200/yr and 1,000 3,000 lbs of CO2/yr)

- 20% match required
- Must show proof of improved efficiency (Utility bills)
- Timeline (August 2021-June 2022)
